The Eugene police installed Flock cameras that scan and store data on your daily movements, recording every car, bike, and person. This goes beyond targeted policing: it's the mass surveillance of law-abiding residents, without warrants and proper oversight.

Flock is Corporate Surveillance, Not Public Safety

Your taxpayer dollars are being spent to build a corporate surveillance network. Flock is a private, venture-backed data broker that profits from collecting and monetizing your privacy data. You are not being protected, your privacy is being turned into a product for investors.

These cameras were installed by Eugene police without public input or City Council approval. This action has undermined our community's trust in law enforcement.

Surveillance Cameras Don't Stop Crime

Flock tracking systems do not prevent crime. Studies also show they have a very high false positive rate triggering unneeded police action. Eugene should invest in proven solutions that keep our community safe, not blanket surveillance.

ICE Uses Local Flock Data To Track People's Movement

Flock systems allow unprecedented levels of government surveillance, both locally and federally. It circumvents your 4th amendment rights to unlawful search without warrant and probable cause. Once the data is collected, we lose control over how it is used.

- Flock has built a national surveillance network that has been misused and shared without oversight such as ICE and other federal agencies.
- Flock usage is opposed by the ACLU, Electronic Frontier Foundation, and the Institute for Justice.
- Flock's most valuable asset is access to the daily activities of millions of Americans.
- Flock have been dishonest about the data captured by their system.
- Flock Safety needs harm, crime, and violence to continue to increase their profits.
- There's little accountability and little that can be done to ensure police follow any laws regulating their use of surveillance data.
